

AERODRIVETRAIN PRIVACY POLICY

1. General

Aerodrivetrain LTD. (“**AERODRIVETRAIN**”, “**us**”, “**we**”, or “**our**”) is the owner and operator of the <https://aerodrivetrain.com/> website and all ancillary functions therein (the “**Website**”).

This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how such information is used, who may process such information and some of the rights you have in connection with the information which pertains to you. This Privacy Policy applies to your use of the Website, so please read it carefully as it will help you make informed decisions about sharing your Personal Information with us.

This Privacy Policy is incorporated into the Aerodrivetrain Terms of Use (which can be found at <https://aerodrivetrain.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/12/TOU.pdf>) and is an integral part thereof (such that, among others, the Limitation of Liability, Indemnification, and Miscellaneous sections thereof shall apply to this Privacy Policy as well). Terms not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Terms of Use.

By making any attempt to use the Website, you confirm that you have read, understood this Privacy Policy and agree to the collection and use of Personal Information as outlined herein. **If you do not wish to be bound by this Privacy Policy, you must not make any use of the Website.**

Some types of Personal Information (as defined below) must be collected by us in accordance with applicable law in order to operate the Website. With respect to other Personal Information provided/collected, you are advised that you are under no legal obligation to provide us with such Personal Information.

If you provide us information of third parties (whether a person or a corporate entity), you confirm that (a) you have received such third party’s consent to provide us with such information to be used as set forth herein according to applicable law; and (b) you have full authority to act on such person’s or entity’s behalf. For the avoidance of doubt, the term “you” when used herein means both yourself and the third party on behalf of whom you are acting.

2. What Kind of information Do We Collect?

2.1. In this Privacy Policy, “**Personal Information**” means data on the personality, personal status, intimate affairs, state of health, economic position, vocational qualifications, opinions and/or beliefs of a person. It is clarified that any consent you provide hereunder also applies to other types of data you provide us with, including any information which relates to you as an identified or identifiable natural person.

2.2. Personal Information we collect may include -

- Contact Details such as name, age, address, telephone, fax and email.
- Technical data such as device and usage information, your IP address, browser and device characteristics, operating system and language preferences.

3. How May We Collect Personal Information?

3.1. We may collect Personal Information when you provide such information and/or when using the Website, for example:

- When you contact our representatives and provide us with certain information or make certain inquiries on the Website.

- When you fill in certain forms and/or provide us with certain documents.

3.2. We may automatically collect technical data when you interact with the Website.

4. Purpose of Data Collection and How May We Use Your Personal Information? We use the information we collect for the following purposes:

- 4.1. To facilitate your use of the Website and to respond to your inquiries, solve any potential issues you might have with the use of the Website and for other legitimate business purposes.
- 4.2. To communicate with you, answer questions you may have and provide you with content we believe may be of interest to you (including information with respect to additional products or services, we or third parties with whom we may collaborate with, may provide in the future). For this purpose you hereby provide your consent to receive “Advertisements” as defined in the Communications Law (Telecom and Broadcasts), 5742-1982, including by way of “Direct Mailing” as defined in the Protection of Privacy Law, 5741-1981.
- 4.3. To enforce and/or protect our rights, property and safety of the users of the Website or any other person or entity. It is clarified that we are under no obligation to do so.
- 4.4. In order to comply with and/or in order to assess compliance with applicable laws, rules and regulations, and internal policies and procedures.
- 4.5. To secure our systems and data, including by conducting analysis required to detect malicious data and understand how this may affect the user and/or our IT system. For statistical monitoring and analysis of current attacks on devices and systems and for the on-going adaptation of the solutions provided to secure devices and systems against attacks.
- 4.6. We may use technical data for purposes such as calculating the Website usage levels, helping diagnose server problems, and administering the Website. Please note that we treat technical, server log files and related information as non-Personal Information, except where we are required to do otherwise under applicable law.
- 4.7. For Internal record keeping.

5. Use of Analytic Information.

- 5.1. We may use the information we collect to generate averaged data, aggregated data, benchmarks, comparisons or recommendations, and other calculations and derivatives, using, containing or referencing the non-identifiable information, and aggregation of such non-identifiable information with or without data relating to third parties (all of the foregoing and the product of such activities referred to collectively herein as “**Analytic Information**”); provided, however, that if the convergence of such information results in the creation of identifiable information, such information shall be treated as Personal Information hereunder.
- 5.2. We may exploit, transfer, lease, sell or otherwise commercialize Analytic Information for any and all purposes without notice or obligation you, provided that Analytic Information does not identify you, and you shall not have any right (including not to any consideration) in connection with the creation or exploitation of Analytic Information. We may use, exploit, transfer, lease, sell or otherwise commercialize Analytic Information, provided that it does not include Personal Information.

6. With Whom May We Share Your Information? We may share your information with third parties as follows:

6.1. When the disclosure is made in connection with the Website. For example:

- We may disclose/provide access to Personal Information to third parties who help us operate our Website. This may include allowing certain third parties to use tracking technology on the Website, which will enable them to collect data about how you interact with the Website over time. This information may be used, among other things, to analyze and track data, determine the popularity of certain content/services and better understand user activities and market trends.
- We may disclose/provide access to Personal Information to third parties who help us develop new products and services.
- We may disclose/provide access to Personal Information to third parties who help us secure our Website.

6.2. When we believe it is necessary to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding potential violations of our policies, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the safety of any person and illegal activities, or as evidence in litigation in which we are involved.

6.3. Anonymized or aggregated data may be shared with third parties.

6.4. When we believe disclosure is necessary in order to comply with laws, rules and other applicable legal requirements.

6.5. We may share Personal information with our attorneys, accountants and auditors as we may deem necessary in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights.

6.6. In connection with a proposed or actual investment in our businesses and/or the sale, merger, or transfer of all or a portion of our business or assets, as well as in connection with a due diligence inspection conducted with any of the aforesaid.

7. How Do We Secure Your Personal Information?

We take various measures to protect and secure your Personal Information and ensure your privacy and we update these measures from time to time, in accordance with applicable law.

We implement what we deem as reasonable technical and organizational measures to protect your Personal Information. However, no method of transmission over the Internet, or of electronic storage or processing, is 100% secure. Therefore, you confirm that you provide us with your Personal Information at your own risk. We strongly advise you to access the Website only from a secured environment. If you feel that the security of your Personal Information may have been compromised, please immediately notify us at info@aerodrivetrain.com.

8. Cross-Border Transfer.

Personal Information may be stored/processed in Israel, EU Member States, EEA member countries (Norway, Liechtenstein and Iceland) and the United Kingdom (collectively, "EEA") and in countries that offer an adequate level of data protection under or pursuant to the adequacy decisions published by the relevant data protection authorities, without any further safeguard being necessary. However, in certain cases we may store or have Personal Information processed outside Israel, the EEA or such countries of adequate protection. Please note that such jurisdictions may have legislation that is less protective of your privacy rights, and you

hereby provide your consent to such transfer/processing (outside of Israel, the EEA or countries of adequate protection).

9. Your Rights.

9.1. In accordance with applicable laws, under certain circumstances you may have the following rights with respect to your Personal Information:

- Right to Access: you may have the right to inspect Personal Information pertaining you.
- Right to Rectify: you may have the right to have us amend or delete your Personal Information that is not correct, not complete, not clear or not up to date.
- Right to Erase: you may have the right to have us to erase certain Personal Information.
- Right to Restrict Processing: you may have the right to limit the way we use your Personal Information.
- Right to Data Portability: you may have the right to move, copy or transfer Personal Information easily from our system to another in a safe and secure way, without affecting its usability.

9.2. You can exercise your rights by contacting us using the details listed in Section 13 below.

10. Cookies and Other Data Collection Technologies

10.1. When you visit our Website, we may collect certain information about you using data collection technologies such as Cookies and browser analysis tools. By making any attempt to use the Website, you confirm that you agree to our use of Cookies.

10.2. Cookies are small text files sent from a web server to your device whenever you visit a website. The purpose of Cookies is to allow us to recognize you quickly and efficiently when you return to use our Website, and in this way to provide you a better, more customized experience.

10.3. Additionally, we and/or our service providers or subcontractors, may use analytics tools, including "Google Analytics" to collect information about the use of our website or other relevant services. These analytics tools collect information such as how often users visit our Website, what pages they browse, and what other sites or apps they had used prior to visiting our Website. The information produced by such analytics tools allows us to improve our Website. The ability of Google to use or share the information that Google Analytics collects concerning your visits to our website is restricted by, and subject to, the Google Analytics Terms of Service and Privacy Policy.

11. Links to Other Websites

Our Website may contain links to other websites, products or services operated/owned by other organizations. This Privacy Policy does not apply to such websites, products and services and we strongly advise you to read the privacy statements and other relevant terms applicable to such websites, products and/or services. We disclaim any responsibility in connection with such third parties' websites, products and/or services and such third parties' practices.

12. Updates to This Privacy Policy

This policy may be changed from time to time, including to reflect changes in our practices concerning the collection and use of personal information, or where required to comply with applicable law. The revised policy will be effective immediately so please check this policy periodically for changes.
